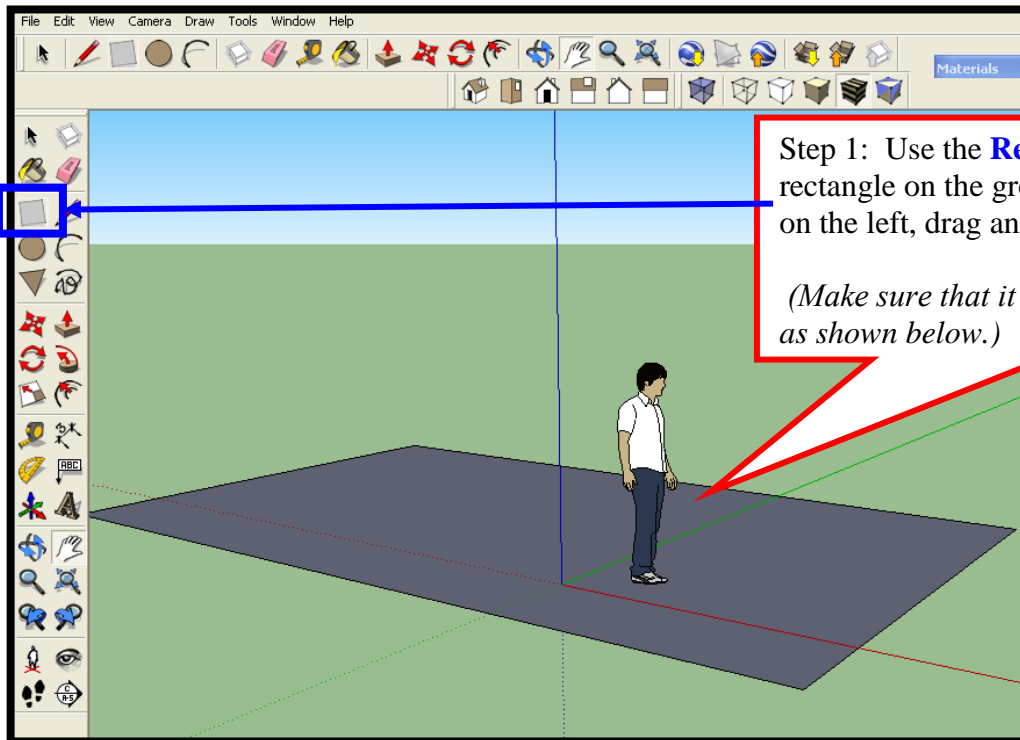
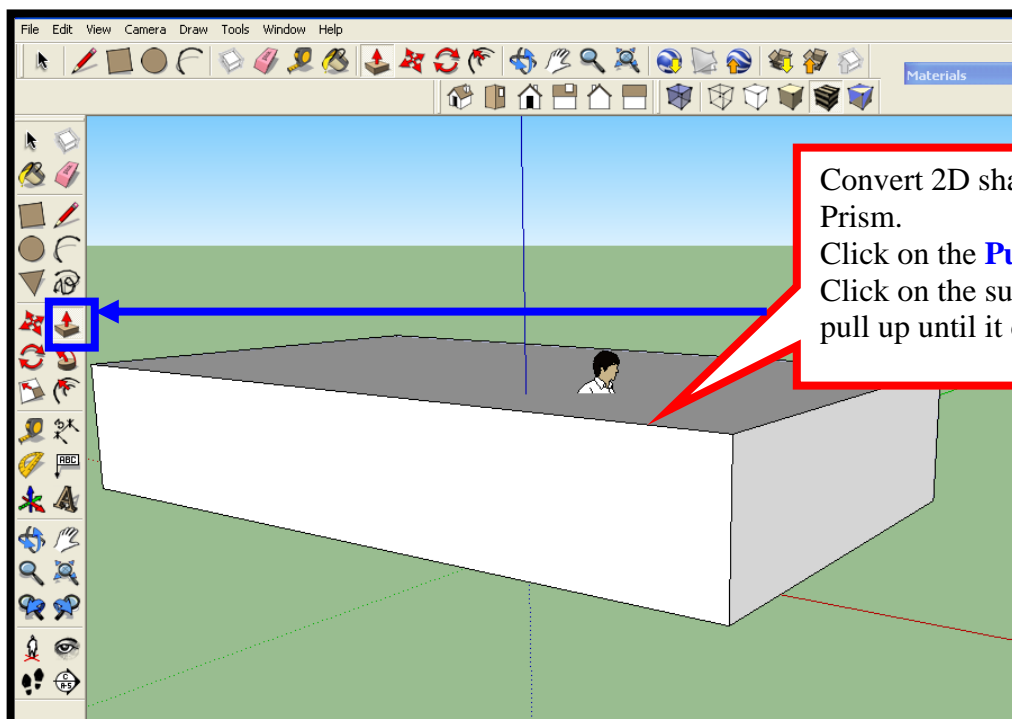


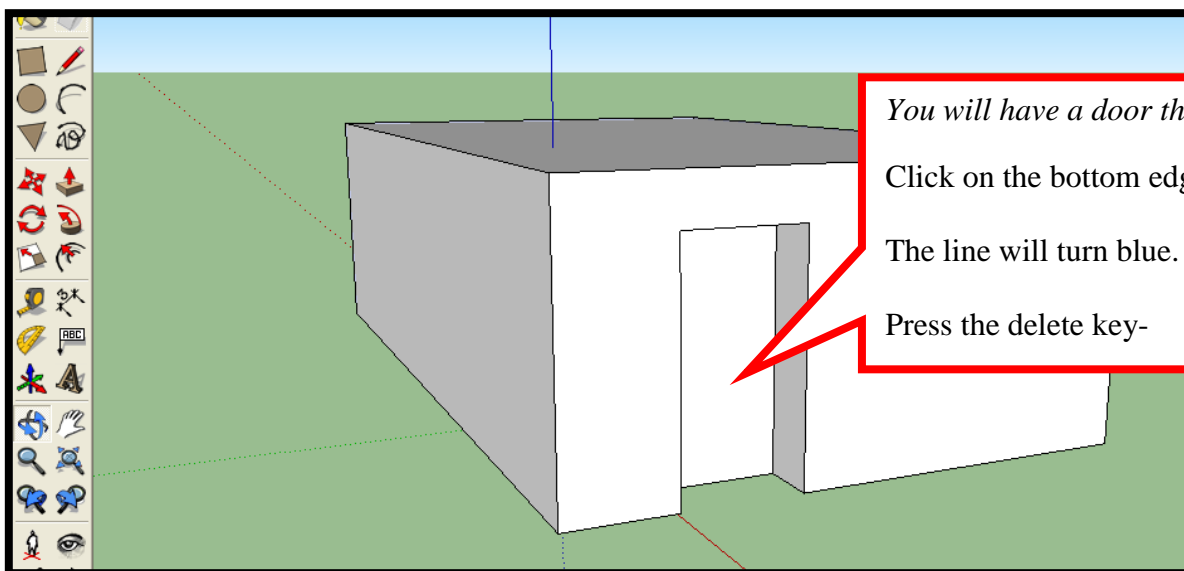
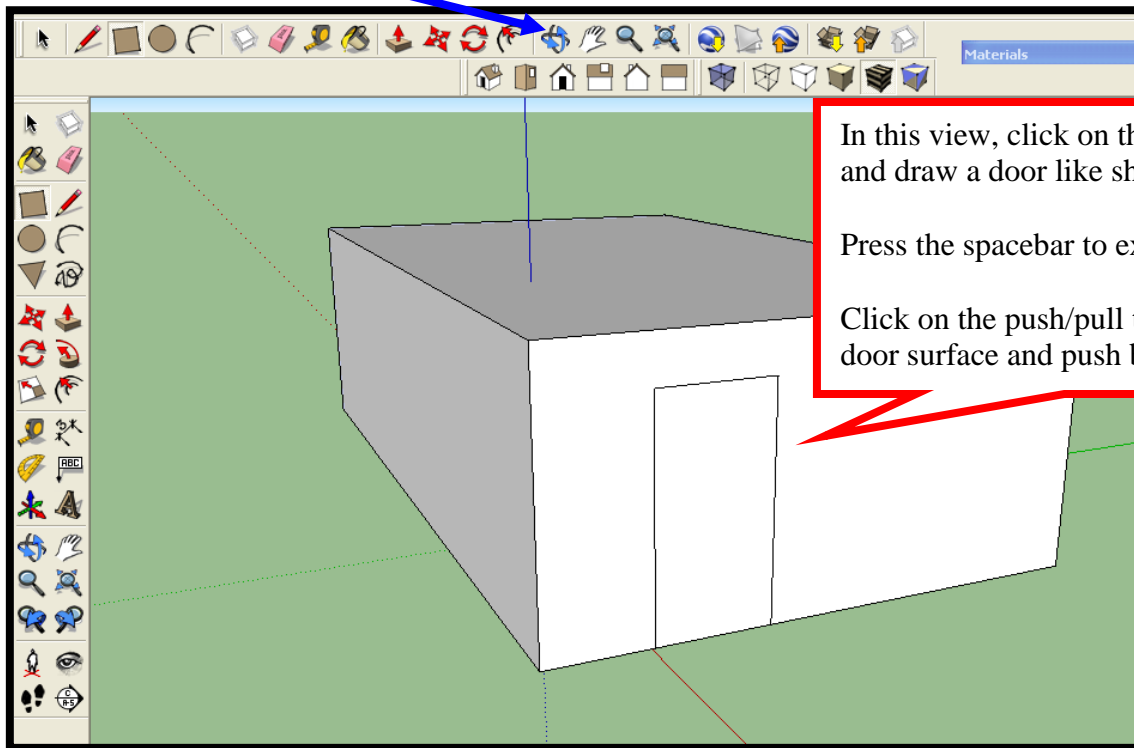
Google Sketch-up: Build a Simple House

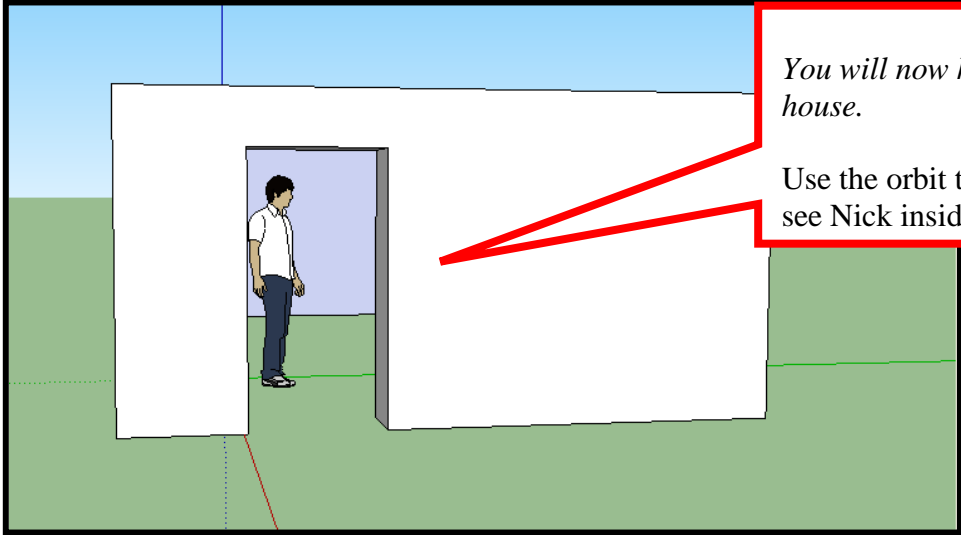


Tip- If you don't see all of your tools, go to View>Toolbars and select them. You'll need Getting Started, large toolset, Face Styles and Views.



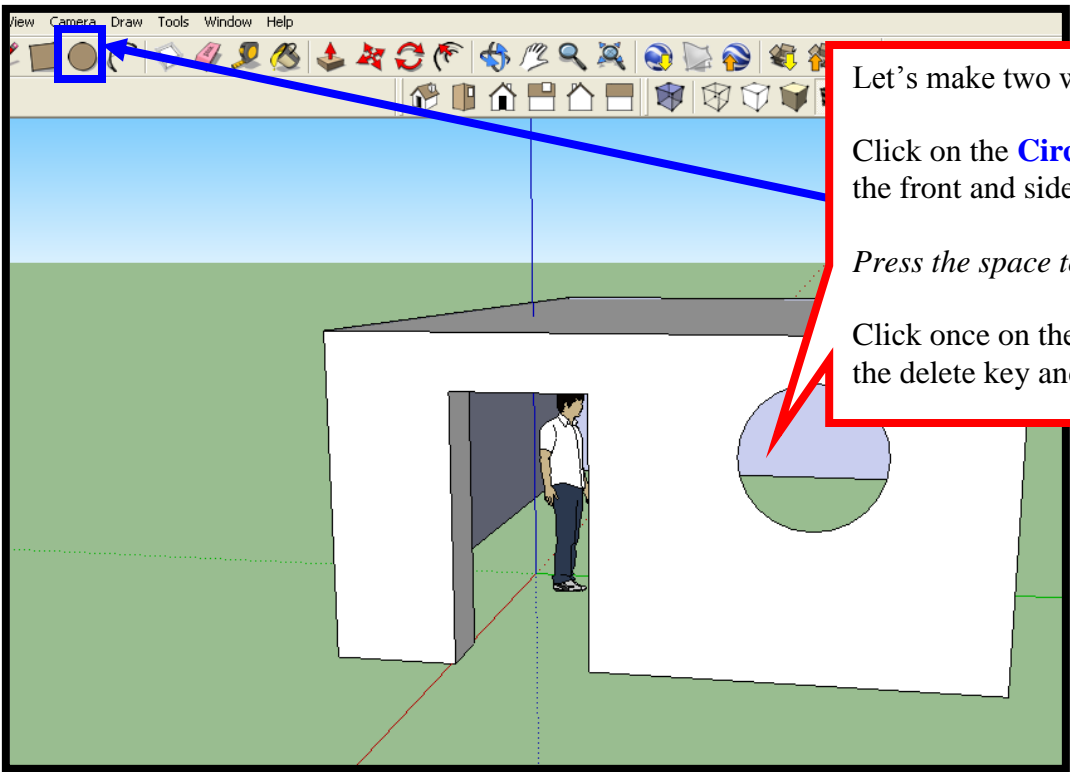
Click on the [Orbit Tool](#)- Now you can spin it around in 3D space.





You will now have a door frame hole in your house.

Use the orbit tool to move around so you can see Nick inside.



Let's make two windows.

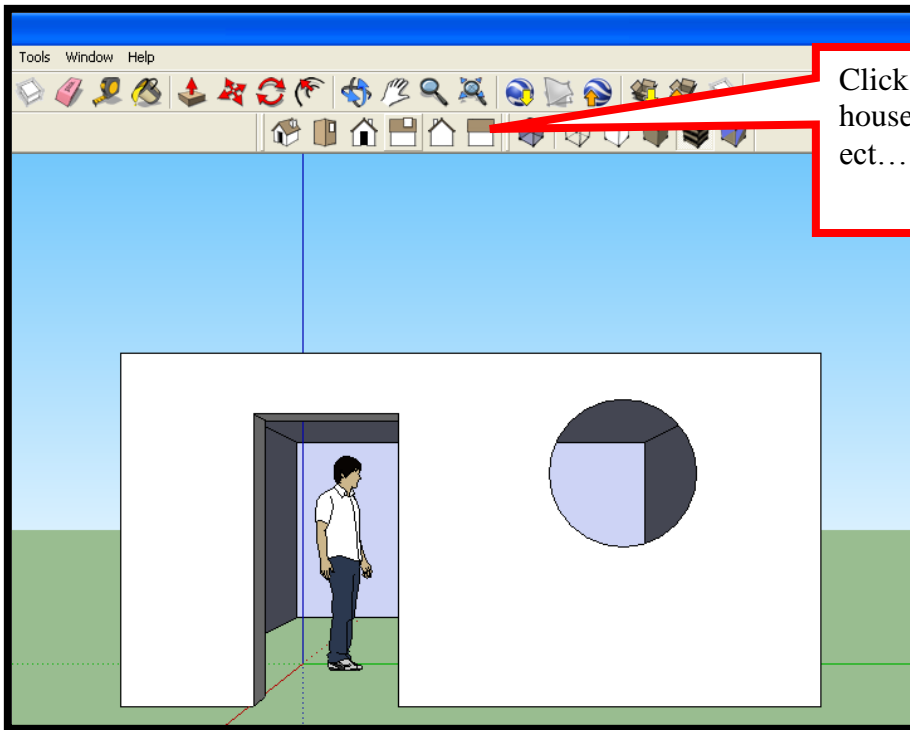
*Click on the **Circle Tool** and draw a circle on the front and side of the house.*

Press the space to exit this tool.

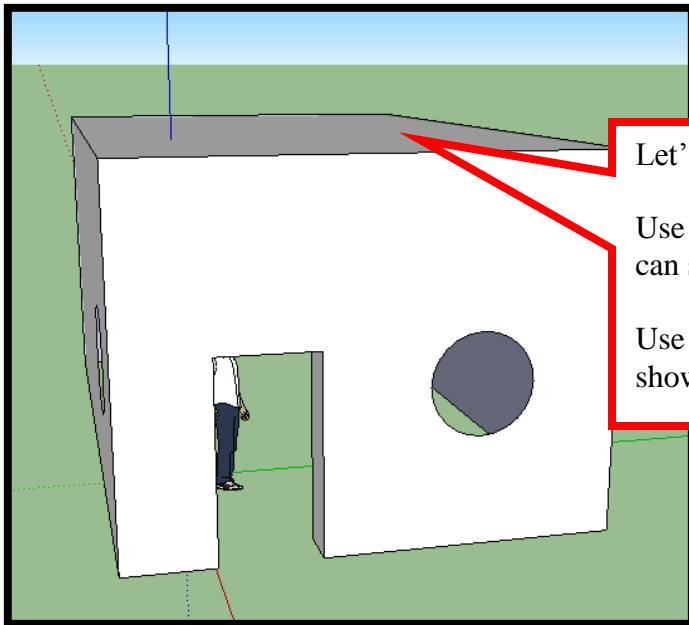
Click once on the circle to select. Now press the delete key and it will create a hole.

- Use the Orbit Tool to move your house around in 3D space.

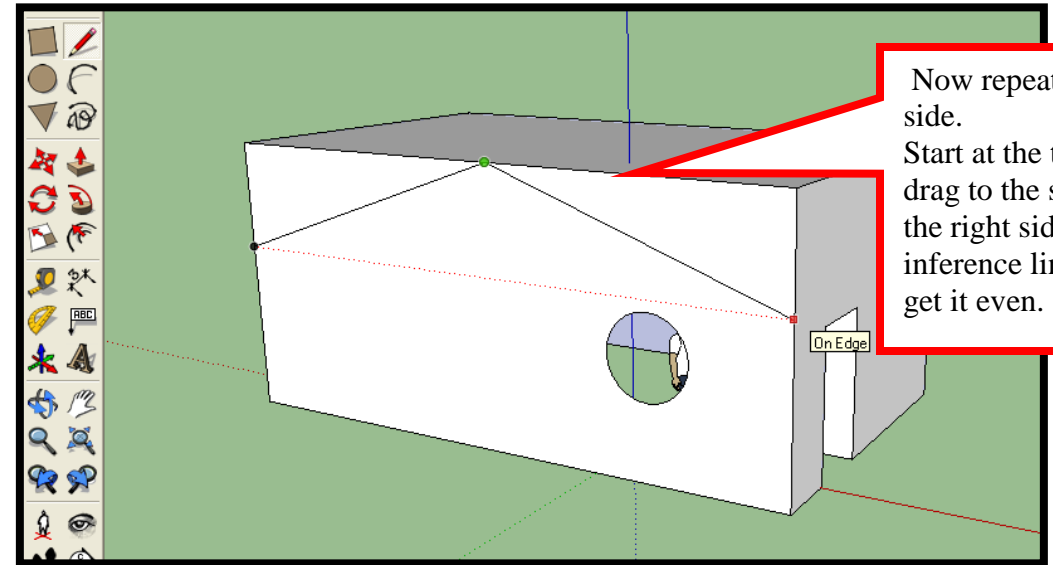
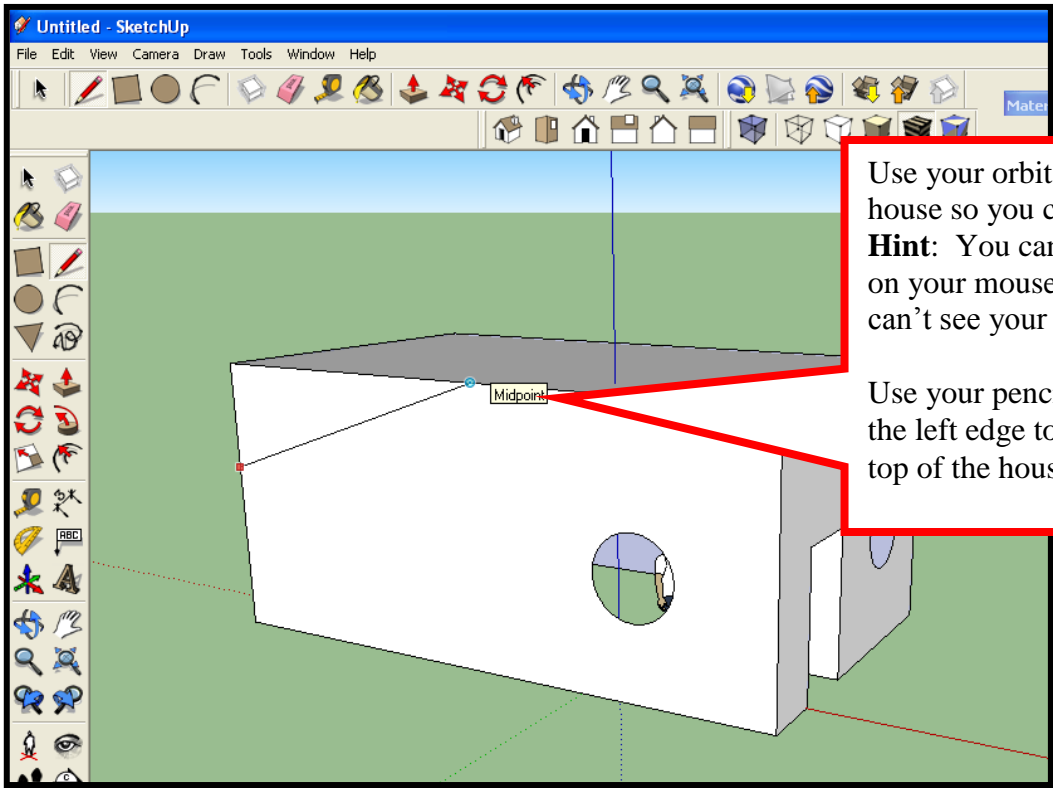

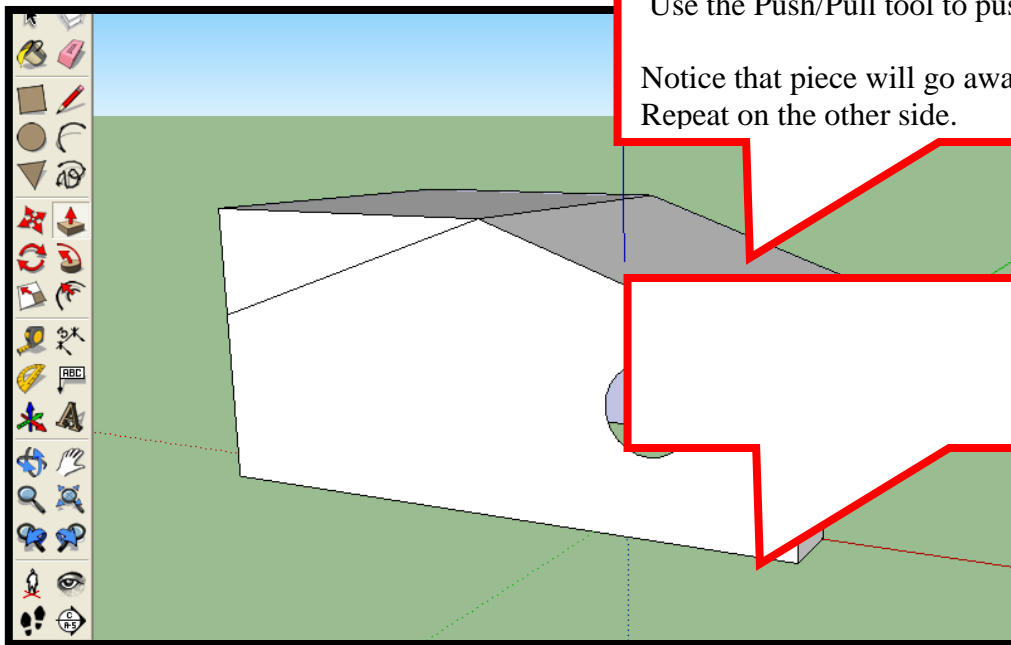


Click on each of the Views to see what your house looks like from the top, bottom side, ect...



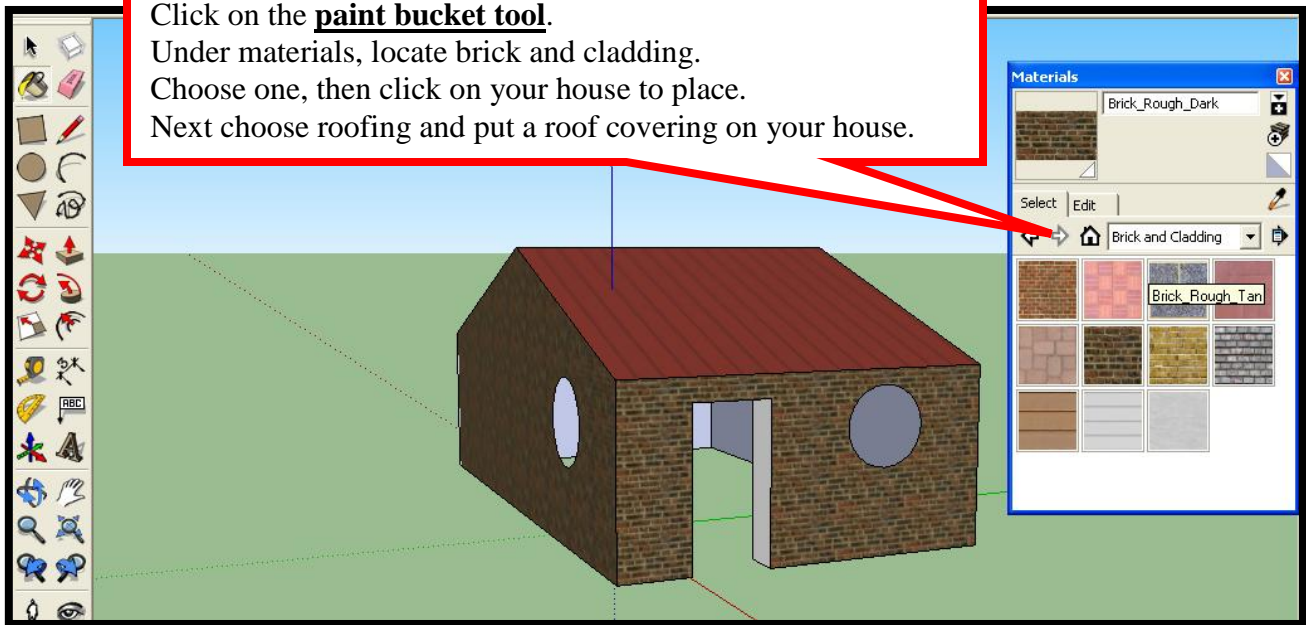
Let's make a roof.
Use the orbit tool to position your house so you can see part of the top.
Use the Push/Pull tool to pull it up higher as shown.





Use the Push/Pull tool to push it back to the other edge.
Notice that piece will go away as shown below.
Repeat on the other side.

Let's add brick and roofing to your house.
Click on the **paint bucket tool**.
Under materials, locate brick and cladding.
Choose one, then click on your house to place.
Next choose roofing and put a roof covering on your house.
